As part of our commitment to education, every year we award scholarships to college-bound high school seniors from our 24-county membership area. This year, 10 deserving students each received a \$2,000 scholarship to attend a college or university in Oregon.

The TLT (Tomorrow's Leaders Today) Scholarship program recognizes overall excellence within our teen members. Over the last 22 years, 221 students have received more than \$240,000 in assistance toward their college educations.

Send money with Pay It Now

Send money faster with Pay It Now, a free, easy and secure way to send money to friends and family or move money between your accounts at Oregon State Credit Union and other financial institutions. Pay It Now is available to members of Oregon State Credit Union age 18 or older with a checking or savings* account.

Look for Pay It Now in your online banking or mobile app

- From your desktop or laptop, log in to online banking, click on the Transfers tab and select Pay It Now.
- On your mobile device, find it under the More tab.

How it works:

1. Enroll in online banking if you haven't already done so.

- 2. Download the app if you haven't already done so (to pay via the app).
- 3. Select the Pay It Now icon.
- 4. Select the person or account to receive the transfer or tap ADD to add a new person or account. If you're adding a new person, you'll need to know their mobile phone number or email address.
- 5. Select the checking or savings account from which you are transferring funds.
- 6. Follow the prompts to add the amount and set a security question.
- 7. Set the frequency. It can be a one-time or recurring transfer.
- 8. Hit send.

Applicants were evaluated on the basis of academic excellence. volunteerism, work and extracurricular experience during their high school career. To be eligible to apply for a scholarship, they had to fulfill the following requirements:

- Be a member in good standing of **Oregon State Credit Union**
- Have opened a TLT Checking account prior to February 28, 2020
- Be a graduating high school senior with a minimum GPA of 2.50 at a high school within our 24-county field of membership
- Be planning to attend a twoor four-year Oregon college or university in the fall of 2020
- Submit an application by February 29, 2020
